A Safe Place For Women To Grow Together

When Spice first started a decade ago by Angela Hughes, most participants were mothers with children. Now, Spice is teaching based on the recent increase in younger newcomers.

After worship, a speaker will speak for about a half an hour. Sermons are Spiritled and can be themed, such as praise & worship, the word, and thanksgiving. To ensure that "everybody gets heard," Kraft said Spice also provides time for comments and questions. Other times the meeting will regroup for Bible study.

Spice meets at The Point's main campus in Caledonia throughout the school year on Tuesdays from 10am to 11:30am. The time offers women a way to maintain their spiritual growth during the week without detracting from evening life groups.

Child-care is provided for a small fee of \$3 for the first child and \$2 for each subsequent child per week.
